

At the Jena University Hospital (JUH), Institute of Occupational, Social and Environmental Medicine (Director Prof. Dr. med. Astrid Heutelbeck), applicants are invited for a

Endowed Professorship for Epidemiology in Occupational Medicine (salary scale W1)

The candidate (m/f/d) will have an outstanding doctorate in the epidemiological field of medical prevention and rehabilitation in the work process to maintain employability and the context factors influencing employability, as well as to integrate itself scientifically with quantitative methods into the research foci of the Medical Faculty 'Ageing and age-associated diseases' and 'Sepsis and infection'. The applicants are expected to demonstrate their potential to produce international publications and their potential for a quality teaching and supervising of undergraduate students, graduates, and doctoral candidates. Experience in acquisition of third-party funding would be an asset.

For this post, all candidates are encouraged to apply who have a university degree in medicine (including a respective board certification), psychology, natural sciences or comparable disciplines, ability to teach and a special competence in scientific work. The length of their doctoral studies and employment period should not exceed six years (nine years after a degree in medicine) in total.

The Professorship is initially endowed by institutions for statutory accident insurance. The successful candidate will be employed for four years first. On a successful completion of the first review, the contract will be extended for additional two years. On a successful completion of the final review after six years of employment, the position will be promoted to a professorship paid on salary scale W2 without additional selection procedure.

The JUH and Friedrich Schiller University Jena are committed to increasing the number of women in research and teaching. Therefore, JUH and the University actively encourage qualified female scientists to apply. In case of equal qualifications, applicants who have a disability will be favoured over the others.
