UKJ is seeking a scientific expert in cellular/molecular physiology of the nervous system. The appointee has to strengthen the research foci and cross-sectional fields of the Medical Faculty.

Requirements include university degree in medicine or natural science, doctoral thesis, postdoctoral thesis (Habilitation) or equivalent scientific qualification. The candidate should have an outstanding track record in publications and extramurally funded research. The Faculty of Medicine offers teaching of medicine, dentistry, molecular medicine, and medical photonics. The lectures, seminars and exercises of the two last-mentioned M. Sc. courses will be provided in English.
