Professorship for Experimental Oncology (W3)

The person to be appointed (m/f/d) will take over the management of the Institute for Translational Oncology, represent the subject in research and teaching and, with a corresponding university degree, participate in patient care.

The main tasks include the establishment of the newly founded institute, the interdisciplinary coordination of basic and translational oncological research based on the research priorities of the Faculty of Medicine (in particular aging research and medical optics and photonics). Active participation in the preparation of the application of the Central German Comprehensive Cancer Center Jena/Leipzig for accreditation as an Oncological Center of Excellence of the German Cancer Aid is expected. Experience in the field of solid tumor biology (molecular tumor biology, tumor immunology, functional genomics) and experience in coordination or scientific support of clinical trials, especially phase I and II, are desired.

Requirements include university degree in medicine or natural science, doctoral thesis, postdoctoral thesis (Habilitation) or equivalent scientific qualification. The candidate should have an outstanding track record in publications and extramurally funded research.

We are looking for a person with strong scientific leadership qualities and administrative skills. Furthermore, sensitivity and openness to economic matters and the willingness to cooperate with different institutions are expected.

The JUH and Friedrich Schiller University Jena are committed to increasing the number of women in research and teaching. Therefore, JUH and the University actively encourage qualified female scientists to apply. In case of equal qualifications, applicants who have a disability will be favoured over the others.
